Terms & Conditions

Classes begin at 10am and end at 4.30pm, with a break for lunch between 1.00pm and 2.00pm. Summer Schools take place at both our North Junction Street and Albion Road Campuses.

BOOKING & PAYMENT

Easter Courses can be booked online or by phoning the School. You can pay by BACS transfer, credit/debit card, in cash or by cheque (payable to 'Leith School of Art'). Fees can be paid in full or your place secured with a deposit of £50. The balance of fees is due three weeks prior to the start of the course.

FEES & DISCOUNTS

The course fees cover professional tuition, use of studios and equipment, core materials and lectures, with the exception of extra quantities of precious metals for jewellery courses. Also included, where applicable, are the cost of models and entrance fees to venues visited as part of the course. There are no hidden costs.

Friends of Leith School of Art also receive an additional discount of £10 per course. A limited number of concessionary places are available. Please note – concessionary places are not eligible for the discounts listed above.

CANCELLATIONS

Leith School of Art reserves the right to cancel courses or deliver courses online if the circumstances dictate. If this happens you will be offered an alternative course, or a full or partial refund of your deposit and fees. If you cancel more than three weeks before the start of the course, your fees will be refunded minus a £25 administration charge. If you have to cancel your place less than three weeks before the start of the course, your fees will not normally be refundable. Non-attendance of a Holiday School due to illness or personal circumstances does not provide the right to a refund or credit. However, in exceptional circumstances we may be able to offer a full or partial refund. In this instance, we request that you outline the circumstances in writing to the Short Courses Manager.
